### **About Kenny G**

Kenny G has a way with melody. That's not necessarily a revelation, but more like a huge understatement, and it really comes into focus at this point in Kenny's amazing career. This is a musician who has sold more than 75 million albums worldwide, owns the best-selling instrumental record of all time with 1992's 12-times-platinum *Breathless*, has the number one Christmas record of all time with 1994's 8-times platinum *Miracles*, and whose song "Going Home" has, improbably, become the official end-of-work-day anthem in China. At the heart of those achievements is Kenny's ability to convey deep emotional resonance with his saxophone, a skill never more apparent than on *Innocence*, his 20th studio album and fifth for Concord Records.

# About Atlanta Jazz Festival Presents: Robert Glasper with Baby Rose

Robert Glasper is the leader of a new sonic paradigm with a career that bridges musical and artistic genres. To date, he boasts 5 Grammy wins and 12 nominations across 11 categories, an Emmy Award for his song for Ava Duvernay's critically hailed documentary "13th" with Common and Karriem Riggins, and a Peabody Award for his Composition of "Mr. Soul!" His work and accolades bridge all aspects of the music business, from live touring to film scoring, composing and producing.

Baby Rose makes healing music for the aimless and heartbroken. The Grammy nominated singer/songwriter and producer's uniquely rich voice naturally lends itself to her powerful, smoke-filled ballads lamenting lost loves and broken futures. "I make music to help myself get through things," she says.

The piercing honesty and vulnerability she brings to her lyrics in turn helps others process their feelings and find a place of healing.

Russell Peters was recently named as one of Rolling Stone's 50 Best Comics of All Time. He started doing stand-up at the age of nineteen at open mics in his native Toronto and spent the next fifteen years honing his craft at clubs across Canada and the UK. In 2004, Peters gained critical and global recognition for his CTV "Comedy Now!" special and soon became the first comedian to sell-out Toronto's Air Canada Centre in 2007. Peters went on to set attendance records at venues from Madison Square Garden to The Sydney Opera House to London's O2 Arena – where he broke the UK attendance record for highest number of tickets sold for an individual comedy show.
